In addition to Government centres we setup additional local centres to help you get your COVID test or vaccination near you, when you need it.



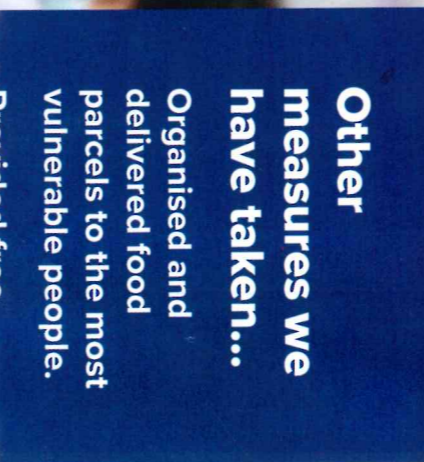
DISTRIBUTED £100M TO SAFEGUARD LOCAL JOBS
